Agenda

A draft agenda for the February 11, 2021, council meeting was presented, and the following items were added: Under *Consent Agenda – 2020 Discoveries and Releases*, and Under *New Business – Item #7 – Appoint Sally Boyd to Park Commission, Item #8 – Park Fee Waiver policy, Item #9 – Resolution No. 193, and Item #10 – Resolution to Request the FBRMPO to Consider the Addition of Bicycle and Pedestrian projects in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan*. With no further changes, Mayor Weedman stated an agenda had been set.

Discussions:

Council Member Dethero mentioned the Halfway Tree Mobile Home Park is 15% complete with a June completion date.

Council Member Carpenter reported NCDOT is scheduled to install the new 25mph speed limit sign on Highway 225 through the heart of Flat Rock the week of February 15, 2021. He also mentioned that on Thursday, February 4, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. at the Park, there will be a stream restoration walk-through with Betsy Gerwig, Henderson County Soil & Water Conservation District.

Council Member Gregory reported the Planning Board will be meeting February 2, 2021, to discuss looking at the Implementation Plan and recommendations.
